## Grant Funder Highlight: American Association of University Women

The American Association of University Women (AAUW) is the nation's leading voice promoting equity and education for women and girls. AAUW American Fellowships support women scholars who are completing dissertations, planning research leave from accredited institutions, or preparing research for publication. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Candidates are evaluated on the basis of scholarly excellence; quality and originality of project design; and active commitment to helping women and girls through service in their communities, professions, or fields of research.

Types of support include:

- ◆ American Postdoctoral Research Leave Fellowships
- ◆ American Summer/Short-Term Research Publication Grants
- ◆ Summer/Short-Term Research Publication Grants

Applications are open August 1–November 15, 2016.

## INFORMATION ON COS PIVOT

The Corporate and Foundation Relations Office encourages you to use COS Pivot, a grant research tool. COS Pivot is a research funding opportunities database that allows faculty and researchers to find research opportunities and funding. Pivot combines a comprehensive, editorially maintained database of 28,000 funding opportunities with a unique database of prepopulated scholar profiles. Faculty have the ability to create, edit, or “claim” personal profiles and get funding updates. We encourage you to sign in by creating your Pivot account. Once your account is created, Pivot will provide you with global and local connections to strengthen your research, and you will be able to explore new avenues for funding and collaboration.
