MASSACHUSETTS LIFE SCIENCES CENTER GRANT

In December 2016, Smith College became the recipient of a \$496,638 grant from the Massachusetts Life Sciences Center (MLSC). Funding will permit equipment acquisition to expand and enhance the training that occurs in both the Center for Molecular Biology (CMB) and the Center for Microscopy and Imaging (CMI). MLSC funding will enhance the infrastructure of both centers and support training in genomic and light microscopy research – foundational skillsets needed for life science careers.

Instrumentation will directly support Smith College undergraduate and graduate training through course-based and independent research experiences, as well as research training of primary and secondary teachers through the college's existing outreach programs.

The Corporate and Foundation Relations Office encourages you to use COS Pivot, a grant research tool. COS Pivot is a research funding opportunities database that allows faculty and researchers to find research opportunities and funding. Pivot combines a comprehensive, editorially maintained database of 28,000 funding opportunities with a unique database of prepopulated scholar profiles. Faculty have the ability to create, edit, or “claim” personal profiles and get funding updates. We encourage you to sign in by creating your Pivot account. Once your account is created, Pivot will provide you with global and local connections to strengthen your research, and you will be able to explore new avenues for funding and collaboration.
